- The external examiner should be independent of the supervisor(s) and/or the student. A dependency relationship is any relationship that may bias the examiner's judgment, such as an academic relationship (supervisor/former supervisor of the supervisor, joint research or grant, joint publications, etc.), professional (the student's supervisor at work, etc.), personal (financial, romantic, etc.), and so on. Relationships that are not personal will normally be considered expired after 3-5 years. Exceptions will be discussed individually, depending on the case.
- At least one of the examiners must be at or above the rank of the supervisor.
- Please note internal and external supplementary examiners, and detail the considerations for preference of examiners if necessary. The final selection will be made by the Advanced Degrees Committee.
